

Bring your 4th, 5th, and 6th grade classes to the Salt Lake County GIS Day 2013 celebration. GIS Day is a worldwide celebration of GIS and its uses. GIS Day this year will be held on November 12th, 2013.

GIS Day in Utah is sponsored by the Utah Geographic Alliance, the Utah Geographic Information Council (UGIC), Salt Lake Community College, the Intermountain Region of the National Association of the American Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (ASPRS), and ESRI.

GIS Day programs present GIS as a technology and show how it can be used in the classroom and throughout students' daily lives. Students learn about GIS and other geo-spatial technologies and how they are used in the real world. Teachers will learn how GIS and other geo-spatial technologies can be used to enhance classroom learning.

Schools should contact Tricia Cannon or Tammy Wambeam for information on scheduling either single or multiple classes or an entire grade to attend the GIS Day Event. Depending on the number of students, the schedule may be adjusted.

To help offset the cost of bringing your class to GIS Day; UGIC "GIS Day" transportation grants are available to reimburse each qualified participating school up to \$250 per school towards the cost of busing the students to and from the activity. Based on available funds, a reimbursement request for additional transportation funds may be approved after the event.

*Reimbursement will occur four to eight weeks following receipt of the request.

The following guidelines must be met in order to qualify for the UGIC GIS Day transportation grant:

- Educators and one or more classes from a grade in your school must attend the event.

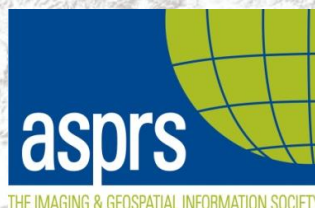
